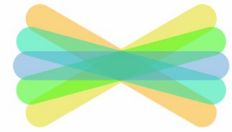
A Parents Guide for Distance

All about SeeSaw

- SeeSaw is an App designed for students to communicate their work to their families, but can also be used as a tool for Learning.
- As SeeSaw is user friendly we have chosen this platform for distance learning for children to;
 - keep students and teachers connected
 - view videos of their teacher.
 - listen to a lesson instruction.
 - send images/documents of their work back to their teacher.
- Teachers and parents can comment on the work to offer feedback to the student

What is the difference between SeeSaw Family & SeeSaw Class

- **SeeSaw Family** is the App purely for viewing a students portfolio and being able to comment on their work. It appears like a news feed. This is the App families have been told to download in the past.
- **SeeSaw Class** is the App where students are able to view teacher messages, upload photos, docs and/or videos of their work. This is the app students usually use at school.

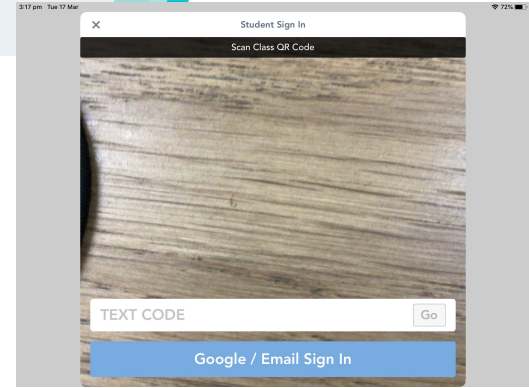

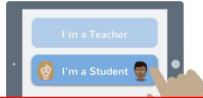


A's Home Learning Code

3. Scan this code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in these letters to access your Seesaw account: **OUHE ADCV XDTE**



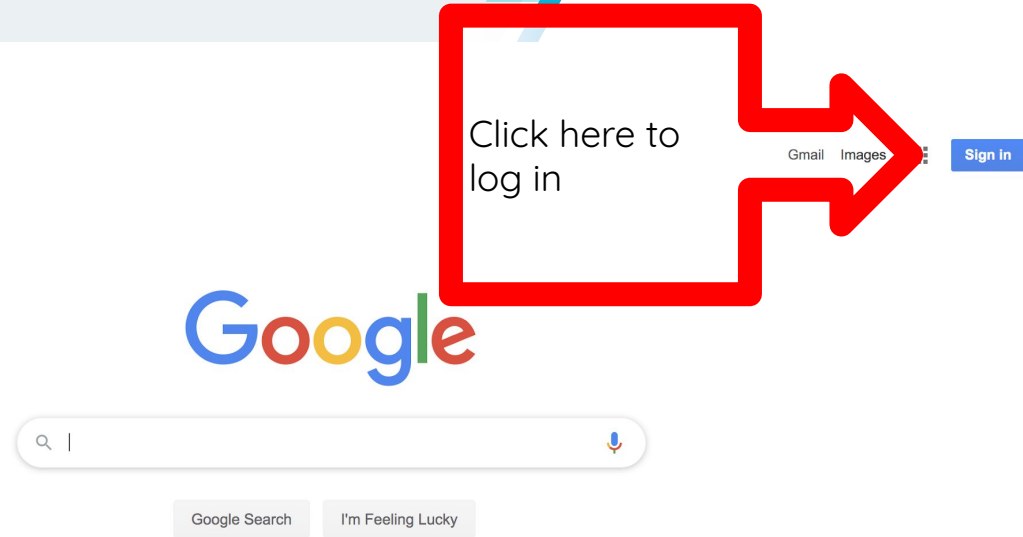





Once students are logged in to Google, they can now head to SeeSaw to log in.

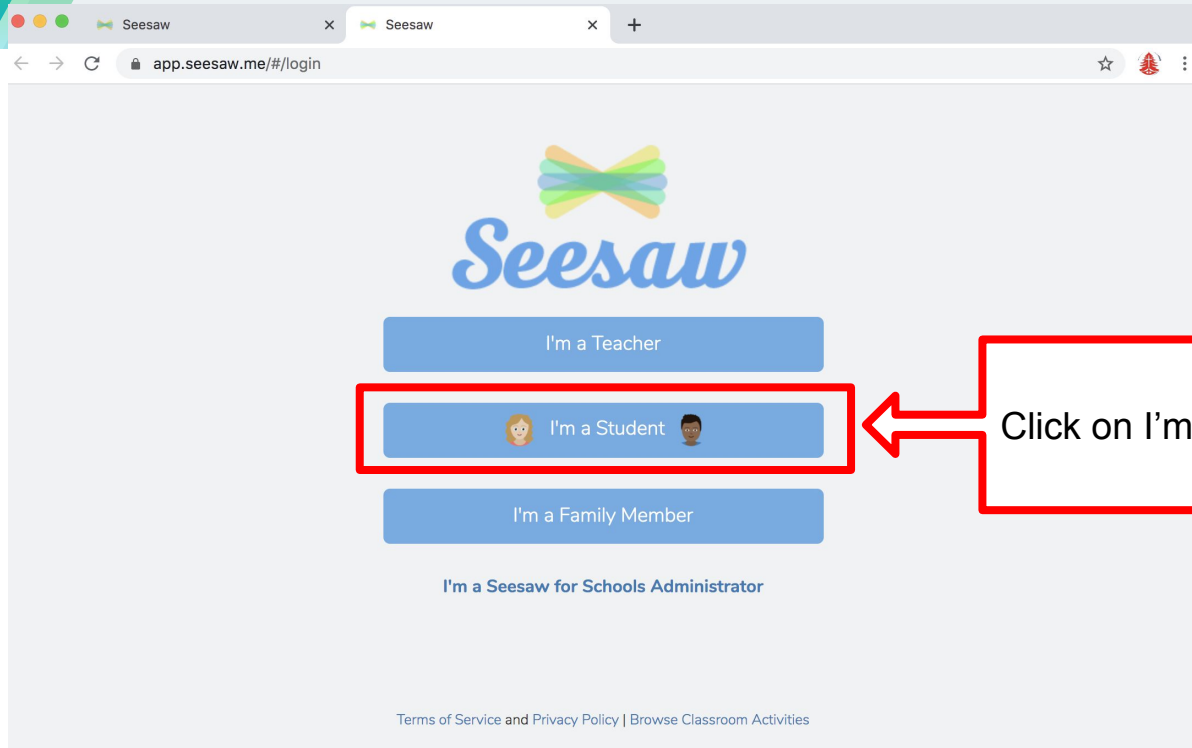

Viewing Journal

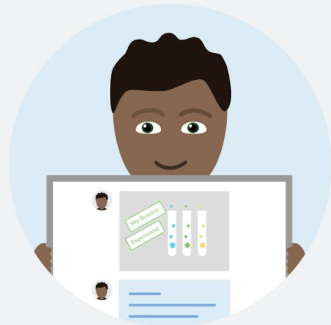
This will be the screen that they view when they log in correctly. With their name and current class visible. The newest post automatically is positioned at the top of the feed. Simply scroll down to view other posts.

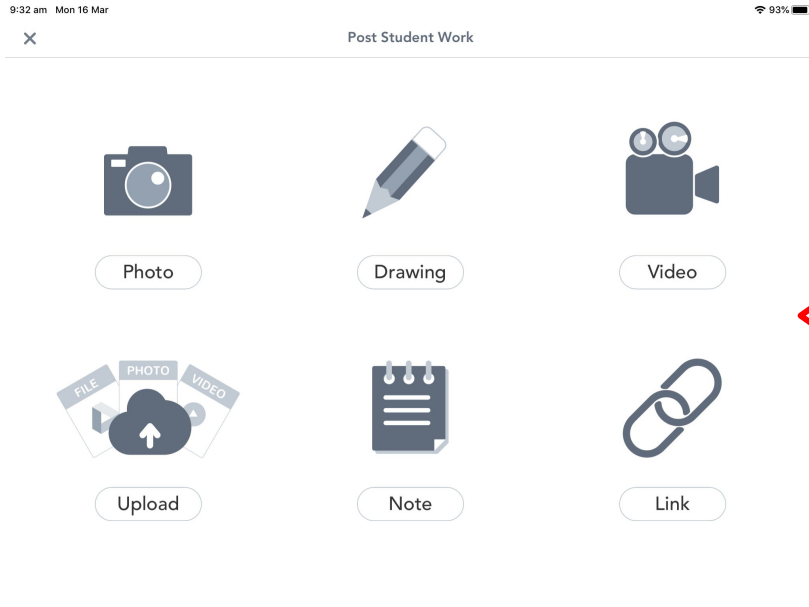
Students will need to check if they have been assigned activities. For students to access assigned activities they will need to click on the light bulb labelled activities, these will pop up in the feed section.

This pop up will appear and students may:

- Take a photo of their work
- Take a video
- Create a note to communicate with teachers
- Draw
- Upload an existing document on their Google Drive/desktop using the upload button.

Foundation or Junior Students are more likely to take a photo or video their work.
Only teacher's linked to their child's class will have access to their work/photos

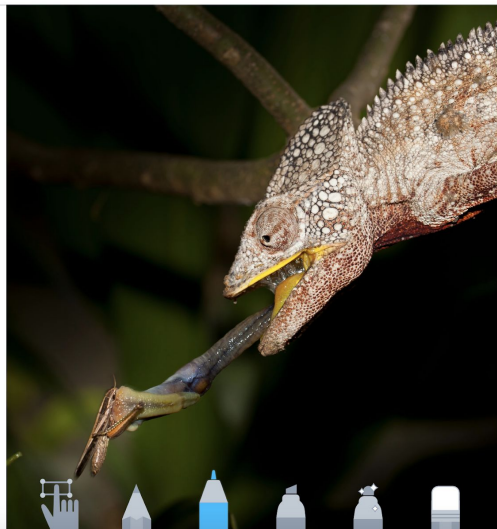
