Dear Parents, Carers, Staff and Students

I would like to welcome students, parents and staff back to school for term four. I hope everyone has had a restful break and is looking forward to a busy and productive end of 2018. Term four has a number of things happening and it is exciting to see the changes that will occur through our building process, the fete is in late November, Journey to Bethlehem in early December and all the activities that are associated with term four.

Building

We are well under way with our building project. The fencing has been placed around phase 1 of the building site and demolition and other essential service work has begun. The building site does cover the lower car park near the basketball courts as well as the corner of one of our basketball courts.

We held an assembly yesterday with all the students informing them of the building site, where they can access areas of the school and keeping them informed of the processes involved. The students still have access to the oval and all other play areas, as well as toilet areas and moving around the school. I will keep you updated on the progress of the building works.
