This holiday, I was blessed to travel overseas with family and friends. While sipping a mango shake and soaking up the sun on a beach in Koh Samui, I couldn't help but contemplate and reacquaint myself with the essential and important aspects of my life.

The first few days of holiday, I was utterly disappointed and frustrated with myself because, although I had planned to make the most of the Easter break by spending time with family and friends, my body decided that it had had enough and was being totally stubborn and only wanted to rest! It made me realise that I so often get caught up in the busyness of life and it can be challenging to find a healthy balance. Talking to family, friends, colleagues, students and parents, it seems that we all tend to face the same challenges.

There is more to life than just existing. So what do I consider to be the essential and important aspects of my life? Personally, I would choose relationships, health, purpose, spirituality and education. Having a group of people I can call family and friends is a blessing. To live a life of purpose means to build relationships with family and friends and to put my heart into my vocation as an educator. Without good health, I wouldn't be able to pursue my dreams, hopes and aspirations. My faith is also important in that it is the higher power that guides me in my life. - 10. Tell me something you know today that you didn't know yesterday.
- 11. What is something that challenged you?
- 12. How did someone fill your bucket today? Whose bucket did you fill?
 - Did you like your lunch?

- 14. Rate your day on a scale from 1-10.
- 15. How were you brave today?
- 16. What are you looking forward to tomorrow?
- 17. What are you reading?
- 18. What was the hardest rule to follow today?
- 19. Teach me something I don't know.
- 20. If you could change one thing about your day, what would it be?
- 21. What made your teacher smile? What made her frown?
- 22. What kind of person were you today?
- 23. What made you feel happy/proud/loved?
- 24. If you could switch seats with anyone in class, who would it be? And why?
- 25. (For older kids):
 Do you feel prepared for your history test?"
 or, "Is there anything on your mind that you'd
 like to talk about?" (In my opinion, the key is
 not only the way a question is phrased, but
 responding in a supportive way).


